Graphic Manipulation

Background: The digital editing tools found in most image-editing software will allow you to crop, rotate, color balance, and adjust the brightness/contrast in photos to improve the images. It is possible to assemble several images into a composite image and to add text to a photograph. Most image-editing programs also contain painting tools, which allow you to add to, enhance, or recolor portions of the photograph.
