
Web Site Specifications

Background: To effectively create a Web site, you must develop a plan that includes all the information needed for the site, including a list of the graphics and the text that will be used. You must also plan the navigation for the site, including page links, using a flowchart. A flowchart visually depicts relationships between items.

Boxes on the same level ha ve equal importance. The user navigates ina linear fashion through the pages.



Boxes placed below show a subordinate role to the main box. The user can navi gate by linking to either subordinate page from the main page.
