Retouch a Photo

Crop and straighten the photo.			
Use the Red Eye tool to fix the dog’s red eyes.			
Use the Clone Stamp to “erase” the water droplet.			
Open the histogram dialog box. Name the new level <i>Color Adjustment</i> .			
Follow Figure 5.38 to adjust histogram settings to lighten the photo.			
Choose the Layer Mask on the <i>Color Adjustment</i> layer.			
Set the Foreground color to black. Use a 150 px soft round brush to restore the original color to the sky and sea.			
Apply a Gaussian Blur to the sky.			
Follow directions to save and print your work.
