## Intranets and Extranets

Unlike the Internet, the intranet is closed to access by the public. An intranet is a computer network used by an organization. It works like the Internet, but its access is restricted to authorized users. A company might keep its employee directory and code of ethics on an intranet. An extranet is an extension of the intranet of a company or organization. It gives authorized users controlled access to the intranet. This semi-private network allows more than one company to access the same information. With an extranet, companies can share information and collaborate.
