







Players: two, three, or four

Materials: 38 index cards, scissors, markers

- Cut each index card in half, making 76 cards.
- Take four cards. On the first card, write a percent from the table on page 220. On the second card, write the corresponding fraction next to the percent. On the third card, write an equivalent fraction. On the fourth card, write the equivalent decimal.
- Repeat the steps until you have used all 19 percents from the table.

- Deal seven cards to each player. Place the remaining cards facedown on the table. Take the top card and place it faceup next to the deck, forming the discard pile.
- All players check their cards for scoring sets. A scoring set consists of three equivalent numbers.
- The first player draws the top card from the deck or the discard pile. If the player has a scoring set, he or she should place it faceup on the table. The player may also build onto another player's scoring set by placing a card faceup on the table and announcing the set on which the player is building. The player's turn ends when he or she discards a card.
- Who Wins? The first person with no cards remaining wins.
