Section 8.1 Assessment Answers

- 1. Mortar or grout.
- 2. Small lumps formed during the manufacturing process of cement when heating changes the composition of the raw materials.
- 3. They are caused when the concrete surface dries too quickly.
- 4. An ingredient other than cement, aggregate, or water that is added to a concrete mix to change its physical or chemical characteristics.
- 5. Answers will vary.

Section 8.2 Assessment Answers

- 1. A test to measure the consistency of concrete.
- 2. It should be covered for at least several days after placement so it does not dry too fast.
- 3. It helps the concrete grip the steel.
- 4. Rebar, which is used most often in footings and walls, and welded-wire fabric, which is used mostly in slabs.
- 5. Answer: $5 \times x = 25$; x = 5.
