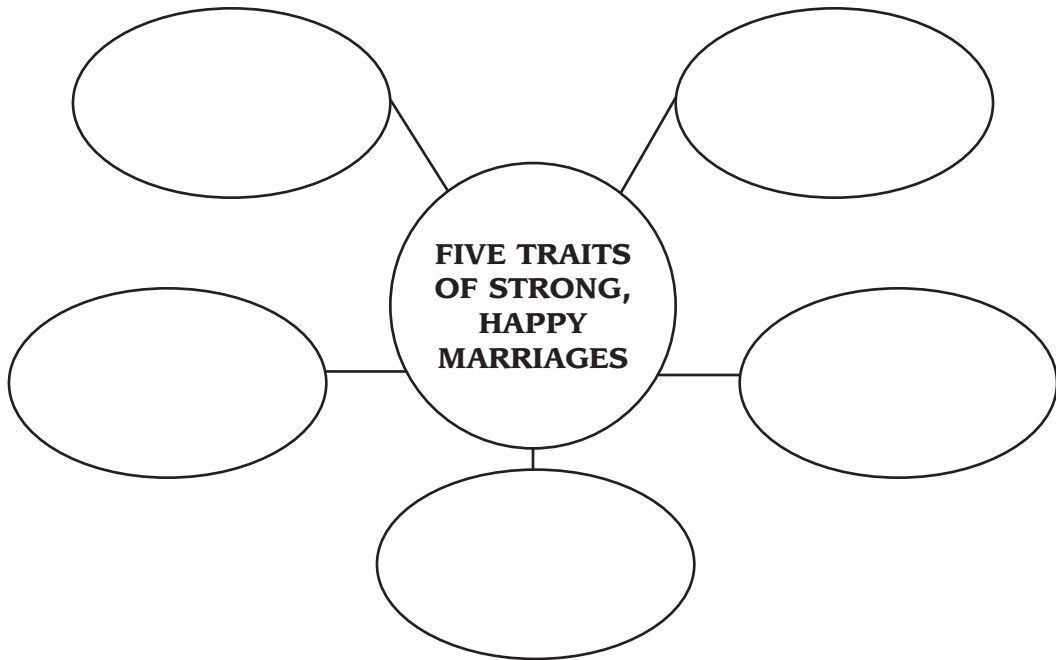

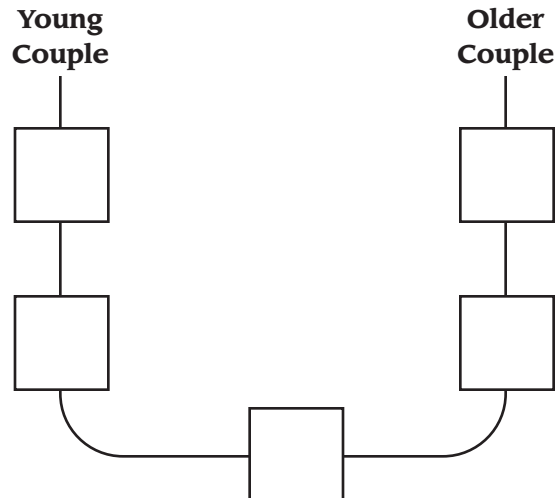
MAKING A STRONG MARRIAGE

- E. High level of satisfaction as middle-age couple enjoys additional resources.

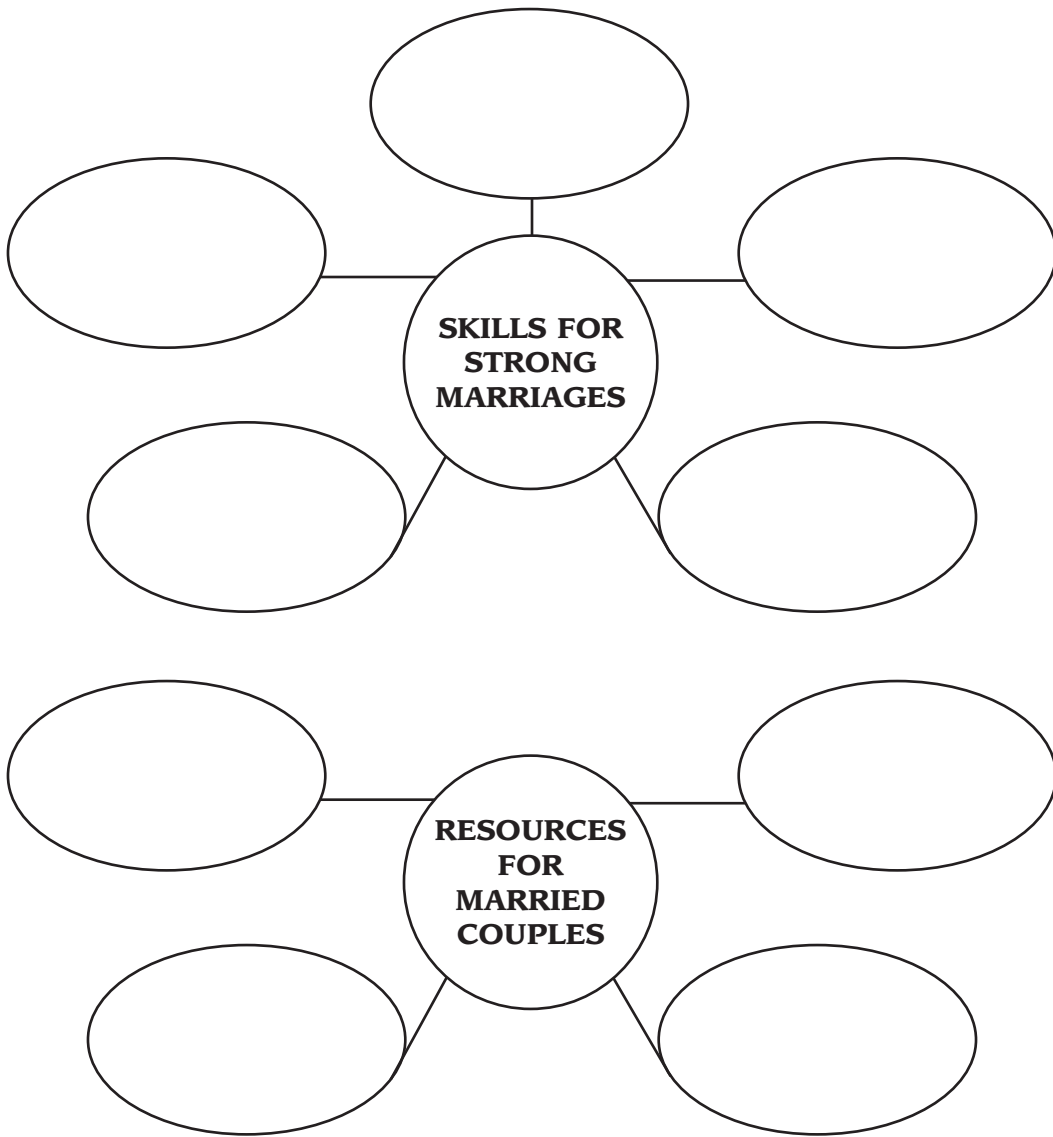
