1. Individuals should consider cost, performance, reliability, tech support, storage space and bandwidth, and additional features.
2. With a personal Web server, a company uploads its Web site to its own Web server. The company retains all the control over the site and how it functions on the server. Using a Web server provider involves transferring the Web site files to the Web server of another company that typically hosts many other Web sites. By sharing the costs of the server with other companies, the cost is often less than what it would be if the site were internally hosted.
