Fraction Rummy

● GET READY!

Players: two

Materials: 27 index cards

● GET SET!

Cut the index cards in half. Then label the cards.

- 4 cards each: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$
- 3 cards each: $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{2}{5}$, $\frac{3}{5}$, $\frac{4}{5}$, $\frac{1}{6}$, $\frac{5}{6}$, $\frac{1}{10}$, $\frac{3}{10}$, $\frac{7}{10}$, $\frac{9}{10}$, $\frac{1}{12}$, $\frac{5}{12}$, $\frac{7}{12}$, $\frac{11}{12}$

● GO!

- Choose one person to be the dealer.
- The dealer shuffles the cards and deals seven cards to each person, one card at a time, facedown.
- The dealer places the remaining cards facedown, turns the top card faceup, and places it next to the deck to start a discard pile.
- The players look at their cards and try to form sets of two or more cards whose sum is one. For example, $\frac{3}{10} + \frac{7}{10} = \frac{10}{10}$ or 1. Cards forming sums of one are placed in front of the player.
- Players take turns drawing the top card from the facedown deck, or the discard pile, and trying to find sums of one, which they place in front of them. To finish a turn, the player discards one card face up on the discard pile.
- **Who Wins?** The first person to discard his or her last card wins.
