Section 10.1 After You Read Answers

Review Key Concepts

1. Students should list two of the following: active listening, commitment, communication, conflict resolution, critical thinking, integrity, and organization.
2. During the design and development stage of a multimedia project, the client evaluates and approves design-related items from the developer and evaluates and approves major media components from the developer including text, artwork and graphics, animation, audio, and video.

Those skills include active listening, commitment, communication, conflict resolution, critical thinking, integrity, and organization.
4. A request for proposal (RFP) is an invitation sent out by the client to potential vendors or suppliers. The RFP explains the intended project and asks the vendors to submit a bid for their cost to complete the work described. The RFP allows the client to choose the vendor based on cost and other factors.

The producer helps to develop the vision for the product, plans and coordinates the development of the project's various media elements, creates storyboards that show the general flow of animation and video, directs the integration of different media into a unified whole, and integrates media using multimedia authoring software.
2. The front end of a multimedia project is the visible part, with which the user interacts. The back end is the part that processes data and makes the production work.
