



Student Best Practices for Video Capture powered by GoReact

Submitting Your Assignment

- Your instructor may require you to watch video tutorials in Connect. If not, you can view these on your own for walkthroughs of Video Capture:

- Pay close attention to your instructor's requirements for the assignment before you begin.
 - Who is responsible for recording your speech?
 - When and where is it supposed to be recorded?
 - Do you need to upload the recording yourself, or is it being recorded within the Video Capture tool?
- Make sure you have a good internet connection.
- Use a desktop or laptop computer for optimal results. There is no Video Capture app at this time.
- You do not have to compress your file before uploading; the system will automatically do this.
- If you plan to upload a presentation file (e.g. a PowerPoint), convert it to a PDF first.



Providing Self-Critiques and Peer Feedback

- Are you required to provide comments about your own speech or give feedback on one or more of your peers? If so, read on.
- Your instructor may require you to use the in-video comment features, a rubric, or both.
- During review of a speech, when making in-video comments, the video will pause once you start to type a comment. Hit "enter" to post your comment and restart the video.
- Any comments and comment markers you post will be labeled with your name.
- When using a comment marker, click the marker to add it to your feedback.
- Feedback from the instructor, as well as your peers will appear all in the same screen and will be available in real time after your speech (and once your instructor/peers provide the feedback).
